Pupil Work



Google Drive Access Issues

Some families have had issues accessing a pupil's Google Drive on a device usually used by another family member, as it defaults to their drive. This can be solved by using the Google incognito feature, as described below:


How to go incognito on Google Chrome on a computer

1. Open Chrome on your device.
2. Click the three stacked dots in the top-right corner of the window.
3. Click "New Incognito Window."



You'll find the option to open a new Incognito window in the three dot menu.

4. This will open a new window in Incognito mode. The window will be dark grey instead of white, and you'll be greeted with a message saying "You've gone incognito." Any new tabs you open in this window will be incognito as well.



You can also use the shortcut "Shift + Ctrl + N" on a PC, or "Shift + Command + N" on a Mac to go Incognito immediately. You can then go to School360 without it opening the usual users Google Drive.
