Lunch costs this term will be as follows:



The cost is £2.50 per day; £12.50 per week; £75.00 for the first half of the term; £60.00 for the second half and £135.00 for the whole term.

Payments can be made via a secure link in a text which we will send, on request, on a Tuesday. A cheque or cash can be sent in a clearly marked envelope, at any time. As we get further through the term a text will be sent automatically to clear the arrears on your account. Texts come from CSD PLUS and refer to a transaction with Northumberland County Council. A text link only lasts 24 hours. There is nothing on the initial link to indicate it is from us but once you click on it more details are available.

Milk this term, will be charged retrospectively at the end of the term. Any child who paid for milk last term will be charged again this term, unless you have spoken to Kathy

We continue to run a well-attended After School club each night until 4.15pm. There are still spaces available for all the clubs. It is also usually possible to arrange short notice, ad hoc sessions if you

It seems likely that the weather will warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves closure, information will be sent by Radio Newcastle as well as the school




remain very cold. Please make sure your child has a in school. In the event of a school bad weather text, and will be on the school, NCC website and Facebook page.
